Founding members and pioneers were acknowledged from the past and present, as well as men and women serving in the military.

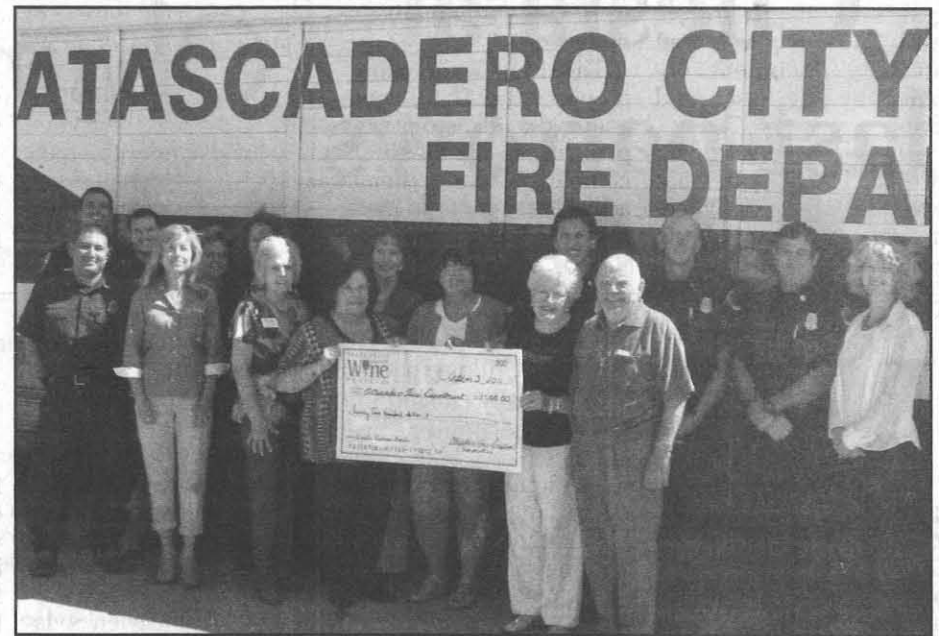
SAN LUIS OBISPO
